

MEDICAL DIRECTOR

MedLink Georgia, Inc., a non-profit community health center with 10 primary care sites in beautiful northeast Georgia, seeks a **seasoned practitioner** to play a key role in clinical management and ensuring the delivery of quality medical care. MedLink was previously named Georgia's Community Health Center of the Year. As a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), the corporation uses the federal support of a USPHS Section 330 grant and program income in its mission to increase access to affordable, quality, primary care. Our 10 sites, fully staffed as primary care group practices, are located in 10 counties in northeast Georgia serving over 35,000 patients annually.

The **Medical Director** has a key role in ensuring that the organization's mission, goals and values are supported and facilitated by the medical staff within the organization's multiple community health center sites. The Medical Director is responsible for the management of the medical staff as well as clinic-wide coordination of the delivery of quality medical care, facilitation of the medical care review process and development of the health care plan.

Experience Required: MD or DO degree from an accredited school of medicine and residency program required. Board certified in a primary care specialty. Currently hold or able to obtain an unrestricted DEA license and Georgia State Medical License. Prefer a highly experienced medical professional with significant time in a leadership role with other providers. Previous experience may include a combination of ambulatory clinic, community health center, or hospital setting with an emphasis on ambulatory care and the supervision of healthcare providers and subordinate medical support. Formal training in clinical quality improvement and medical management preferred. The Medical Director will provide direct supervision to Site Physician Leaders and the Nurse Manager.

Additional Information: This position may be full-time with split responsibilities between Medical Director duties at the administrative offices in Colbert and clinical duties at one of the MedLink sites; or it may be part-time, approximately 16 hours per week, for a physician seeking fewer hours. S/He must have excellent interpersonal skills and be willing and able to foster teamwork and collaboration among physicians and staff and adapt to the organization's changing business needs based on the clinical assessments/demands of the target patient population.

Benefits include group health insurance options, 403B retirement plan, flexible spending account, paid time off, company paid life and disability insurance.
